The newly-elected committee met for a first meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> January. Here is a summary:

### **Finance**

Danny reported that we have about £4,000 in the bank.

It was unanimously agreed that the annual membership subscription should be set to zero for 2026.

### **Looking Ahead**

All agreed that it was the group's aspiration to try to put on two shows per year. However, it was recognised that our capability to do two large productions in the same year depends (not least) upon the availability of backstage crew members.

Marian Cox said she would like to direct *Abigail's Party* next year, maybe springtime, preferably at Warton Village Hall (WVH) rather than the Heron.

Marion Plowright said she would like to direct Chekhov's *Seagull*, perhaps in 2027, at the Heron or maybe WVH too.

The meeting was enthusiastically supportive, and noted that these were nicely contrasting plays..

A sub-committee has been formed to consider the details of staging these two plays.

Ideas for enticing new members to join the group - particularly backstage crew members - were discussed. Jo proposed doing a workshop or community event in WVH over two weekends in the summer or during the October half-term this year. It would not have the aim of staging a production, but rather to recruit of new members, backstage crew particularly. It would also provide an 'acting taster' opportunity for anyone minded to try acting in a small part and with no obligation.

A reminder - members are welcome to attend committee meetings (but are not entitled to vote). The next meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday 17th March 2026**. (Time & venue TBC).
